ABSTRACT SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**ABSTRACT STRUCTURE**

- ✓ The **TITLE** of the abstract should be centered, written in **CAPITAL LETTERS** and in bold font;
- ✓ The author's surname and first name (full) should be written in italics on a new line;
- ✓ Name of the institution;
- ✓ If authors represent different institutions, surnames and first names should include superscript numerical institutional affiliations (for example: Ivan Petrenko¹, Petro Ivanenko²). Corresponding institutions should be indicated below on separate lines:

² — ...

- ✓ **Keywords** — at least 5 words;
- ✓ The text should follow this structure:

Relevance of the problem

Aim of the study

Materials and methods

Research results

Conclusions

References

The word “**References**” should be placed one line below the main text, followed by the list of references. The reference list should be formatted in APA style. Authors are responsible for the content of submitted materials. The editorial board reserves the right to check submitted abstracts for plagiarism and guarantees copyright protection during the review process.

The volume of abstracts should be 1–3 A4 pages. Materials should be submitted in Microsoft Word for Windows format.

Technical formatting requirements:

- margins — 2 cm on all sides;
- font — Times New Roman;
- font size — 14 pt;
- line spacing — 1.0;
- paragraph indentation — 1.25 cm.
